



History Faculty Position

The Social Sciences Department of Emmanuel College invites applications for a full-time faculty position beginning with the Fall Semester of 2021. Candidates should expect to teach courses in both general education courses and upper level courses within the history major.

Emmanuel College is a coeducational liberal arts college of 800+ undergraduate students nestled in the hills of northeast Georgia. The candidate will be required to demonstrate an ability to effectively teach undergraduate students and must be a committed Christian who can identify and adhere to the mission of the institution.

The college offers a major and a minor in history and, within the School of Education, degrees in secondary and middle grades history/social science education.

Salary & Benefits: Salary is commensurate with degree and experience. Benefits include, but are not limited to, health insurance coverage beginning the first of the month following your hire date, retirement plan options, paid holidays, paid sick leave, and tuition reduction for immediate family.

Faculty Qualifications: A Ph.D. in the field of American History from an accredited institution is strongly preferred. A minimum of a master's degree with advanced study in History from an accredited institution is required. Applicants must have the ability to meet Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) requirements, in particular a minimum of 18 graduate hours in the teaching discipline. Familiarity with using learning management systems is a plus.

- **Unofficial transcripts from all graduate schools attended** (scans of "student issued" copies are acceptable for the application phase)
- **Personal Testimony:** An explanation of the applicant's relationship with God through the Lord Jesus Christ, including a brief account of accepting Christ as personal savior, church membership, and current church involvements.
- **Pastoral Letter of Recommendation:** Needs to be from a current pastor and to include a verification of current church attendance and/or membership, a description of the applicant's activity in the local congregation, and an evaluation of the quality of the candidates' personal commitment to Christ. (Upon request, this may be supplied later in the application process.)
