Style of residence hall: Community Hall Style

Bathroom: Each hall has a community bathroom/shower area with 6 stalls, 4 sinks, and 4 covered showers.

Potential total # of students in residence hall: 99.

Potential total # of students on each hall: The number of students on each hall ranges from 21 to 26

Residence hall room dimensions: Jackson is unique and has the widest variety of room sizes ranging from small, single occupancy rooms, to larger double rooms.

Bed dimensions: Each bed fits a standard twin mattress. Twin XL beds may be available to students taller than 6'2" upon request (depending on inventory availability).

Amenities/furniture included: In all rooms, each resident receives a twin-size bed, desk and chair, bookshelf, wardrobe/dresser. Several rooms may include a nightstand; however, these are limited. Central laundry area is located on the ground floor of the dorm; washers and dryers are quarter operated.

Heating & air: Central heating and air. The temperature on each hall is controlled by a thermostat that is located in the hallway.

Jackson's stand-out features:

- Being one of the oldest buildings on campus, Jackson Hall has unique qualities that many students love!
- The large main lobby is located at the center of the building and is the location where many Residence Life community events are held.
- Other lobbies in Jackson: "The Max" downstairs lobby, which includes a full kitchen area that is available for students to use upon request. The "Purple Lobby"/study room holds a conference table for group work and four private study carrels.
