

# Wellons Hall

**Style of Residence Hall:** Community Hall Style

**Bathroom:** Each hall has a community bathroom/shower area with 4 stalls, 2 urinals, 4 sinks, and 4 covered showers. Note: Wellons 1st floor bathroom/shower area is smaller due to the hallway's lower occupancy numbers. The 1st floor bathroom contains 2 showers, 2 sinks, 1 stall, and 1 urinal.

**Potential total # of students in Residence Hall:** Maximum of 88.

**Potential total # of students on each hall:** The average number of students on the 2nd and 3rd floor ranges from 30 - 37 students through the school year. Wellons 1st floor is unique in its much smaller size and holds an average of 8 - 10 students through the school year.

**Residence hall room dimensions (avg.):** 14' x 12' (certain rooms may vary slightly). Single-occupancy rooms are slightly smaller than double occupancy rooms.

**Bed dimensions:** Each bed fits a standard twin mattress. Twin XL beds may be available to students taller than 6'2" upon request (depending on inventory availability).

**Amenities/furniture included:**

In all rooms, each resident receives a twin-size bed, desk and chair, and large wardrobe/dresser set for personal use. The building's laundry area is located on the first floor of the dorm; washers and dryers are quarter operated and cost \$1.00/cycle.

**Heating & air:**

Central heating and air. The temperature on each hall is controlled by a thermostat located in the RA's room.

**Wellons Hall stand-out features:**

- Wellons Hall's distinctive community style set-up lends itself to close camaraderie and tight-knit friendships!
- The Wellons main lobby (renovated and expanded in 2020) is located at the center of the building on the first floor and has multiple rooms with different features. Each room in the main lobby area is a community location where students can lounge, socialize, study, watch tv, play video games, or enjoy one of several game tables (like ping-pong, foosball, or pool). Some game table equipment is provided by the College while other equipment may need to be self-provided.
- Wellons Hall community-building events are also hosted by RAs and other community members inside these main lobby spaces.
- The Wellons Plaza (constructed in 2020) located just outside and next to the Wellons building is equipped with outdoor furniture, recreational activities, a small stage for performances/events, hammock hang-points, lighting for night use, and an outdoor grill.
- A full community kitchen area where students can cook in a microwave, oven, or on stovetop, buy snacks/drinks from vending machines, wash dishes, and make use of community refrigerator and freezer space.
