- **Personal Testimony:** An explanation of the applicant's relationship with God through the Lord Jesus Christ, including a brief account of accepting Christ as personal savior, church membership, and current church involvements.
- **Pastoral Letter of Recommendation**:** Should be from a current pastor and must include a verification of current church membership, a description of the applicant's activity in the local congregation, and the pastor's perception of the candidates' personal commitment to Christ. (**Upon request, this may be submitted later in the application process.)

Applications will not be considered until all requested documents have been received.

Employment is contingent upon successful completion of a background check (including driver's history) and drug screen that determines you are able to perform the essential job functions. It is also subject to your providing appropriate documentation to establish your eligibility to be legally employed in the United States. Employee sponsorship is not available for this position.
